



Badge Maker Loan

The Children's Ministry Department of the SEC has a badge-maker machine for you to loan. You are very welcome to borrow it. It makes badges, key rings, bottle-openers, mirrors and magnets that are 55mm in diameter – please confirm whether your preferred badge components are in stock when ordering.

Borrowing the Badgemaker

To borrow the machine you need to:

1. Book your exact dates for collecting and returning the badge-maker with the departmental secretary on cm@secadventist.org.uk, or 01923 232728. It is very heavy and needs to be collected and returned to the office by someone who has a car.
2. Send a separate cheque made payable to 'South England Conference' for £50 as a security deposit, which will be returned to you when you return the badge-maker.
3. Purchase the badge components from us (see prices below).
4. **Or** order your components directly from the manufacturer if you plan to make large amounts of badges, mirrors, or magnets or key rings as we cannot afford to carry lots of stock.
5. Read the instructions for use very carefully as it is an expensive machine and there are also health and safety rules you need to consider, such as anchoring it to a secure surface with the D-clamps. If these clamps do not fit the surface you have, you will need to find appropriate clamps yourself from a hardware store.
